BYLAWS  $\sim$  Chapter 8.  $\sim$  C8.05.01 A confirmed member who does not, for a period of one year, commune or make a contribution of record, and does not appear to participate in the life and worship of this congregation shall be visited by the pastor and an officer of the congregation and encouraged by them to active membership. If, during the second year, the confirmed member does not actively participate, that member's name shall be removed from the active membership rolls of this congregation by action of the Congregation Council.

The Malta Lutheran Church does need to keep record of active members for voting privileges and to meet MT Synod requirements. Even though this ByLaw may seem worded harshly, MLC never wishes to remove a congregate from active membership.
